Fridays: 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m.

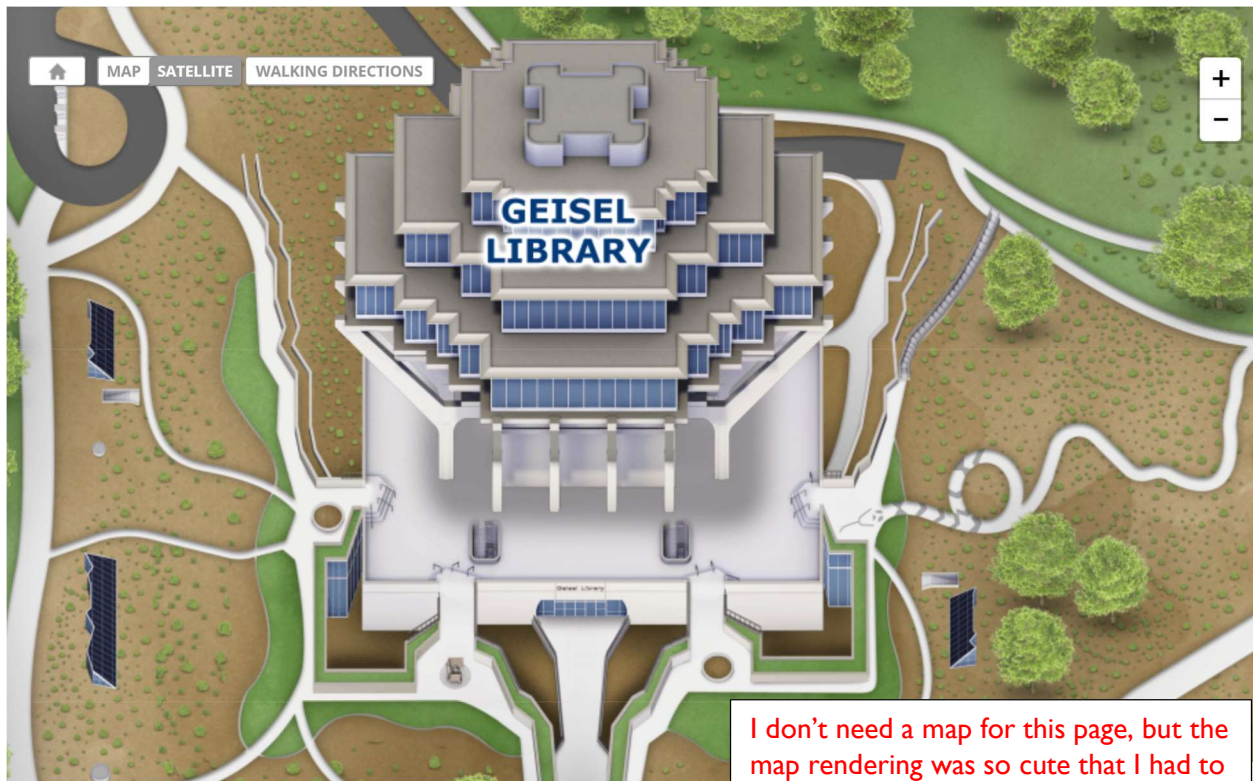
Saturdays: 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Mondays open at 6:30 a.m.; then open 24 hours through Friday at midnight

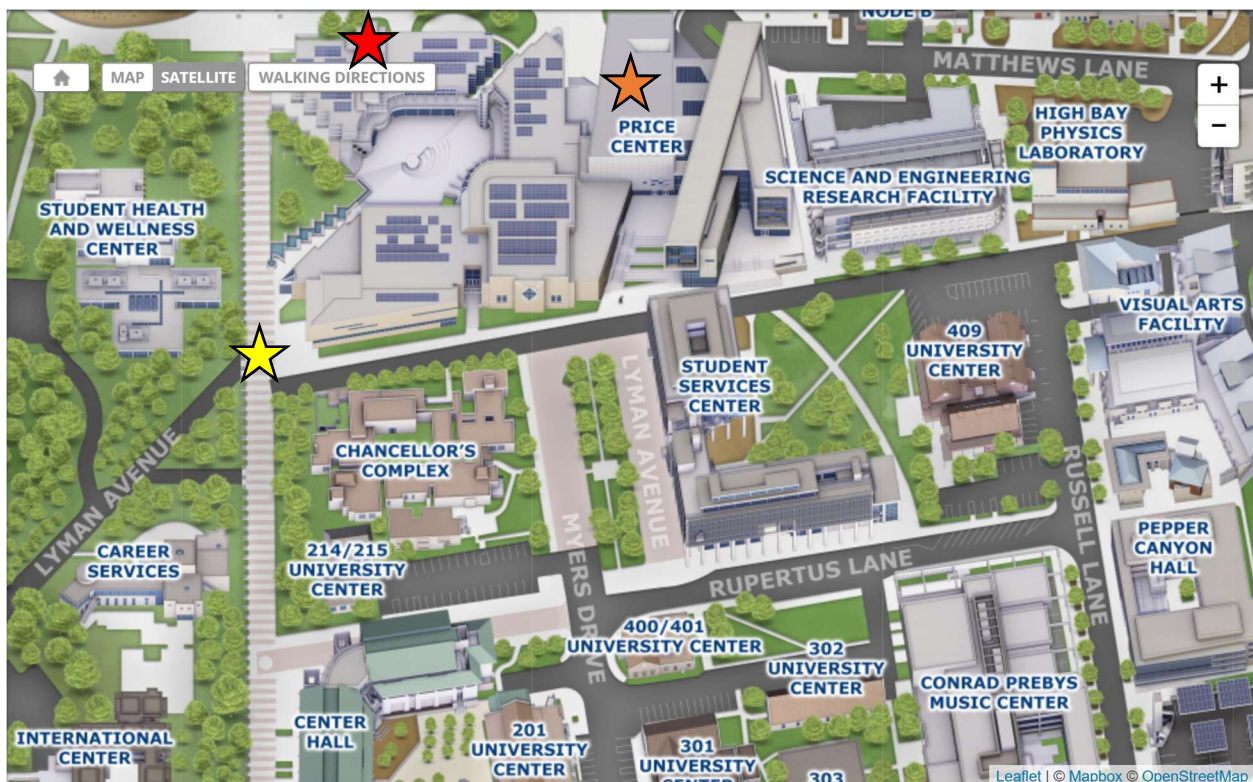
Saturdays: 8 a.m. to midnight

★ ROOTS Restaurant

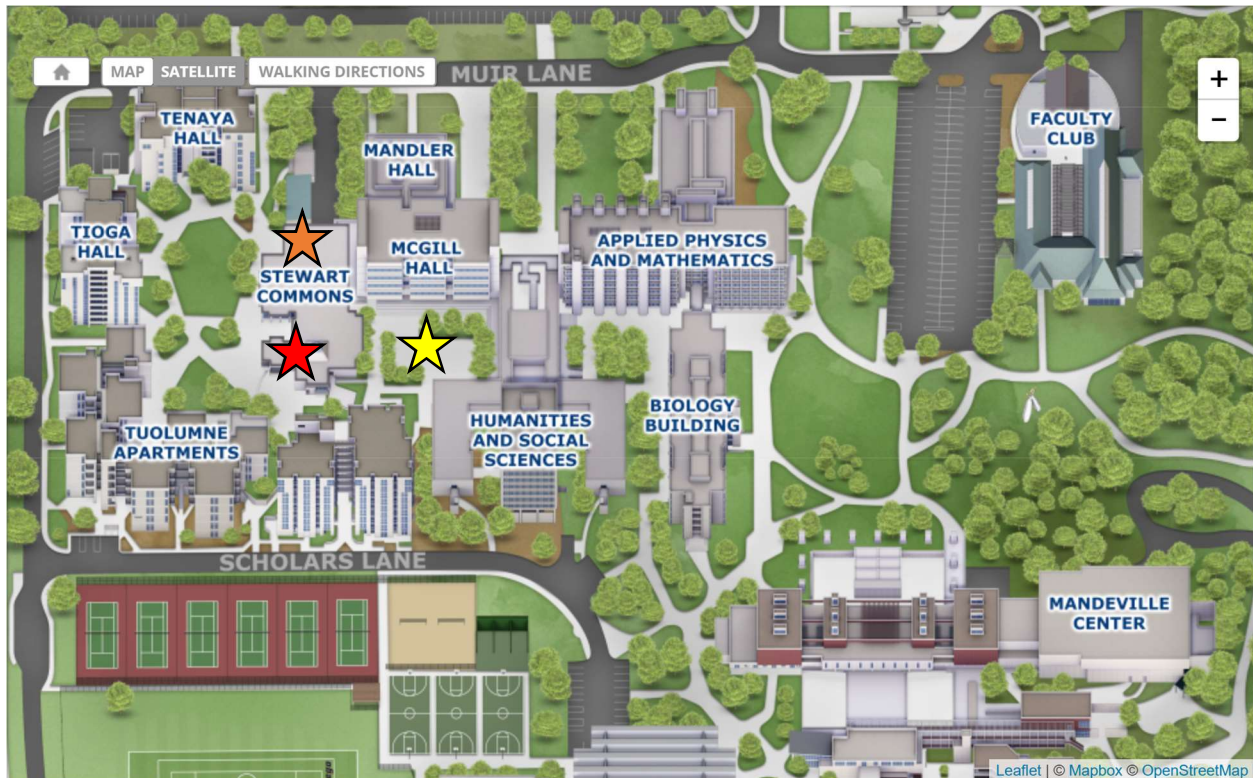
Hours:

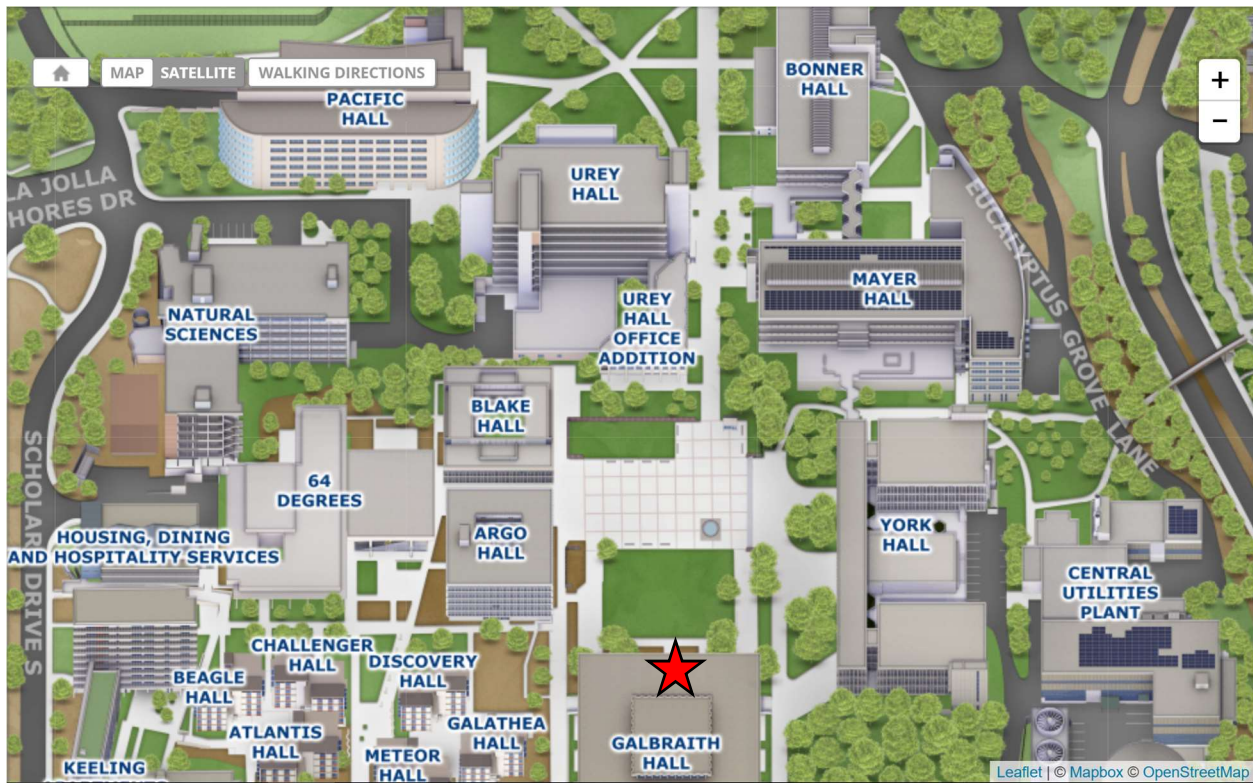

RIMAC Annex Glider Lounge (located above Peet's Coffee)

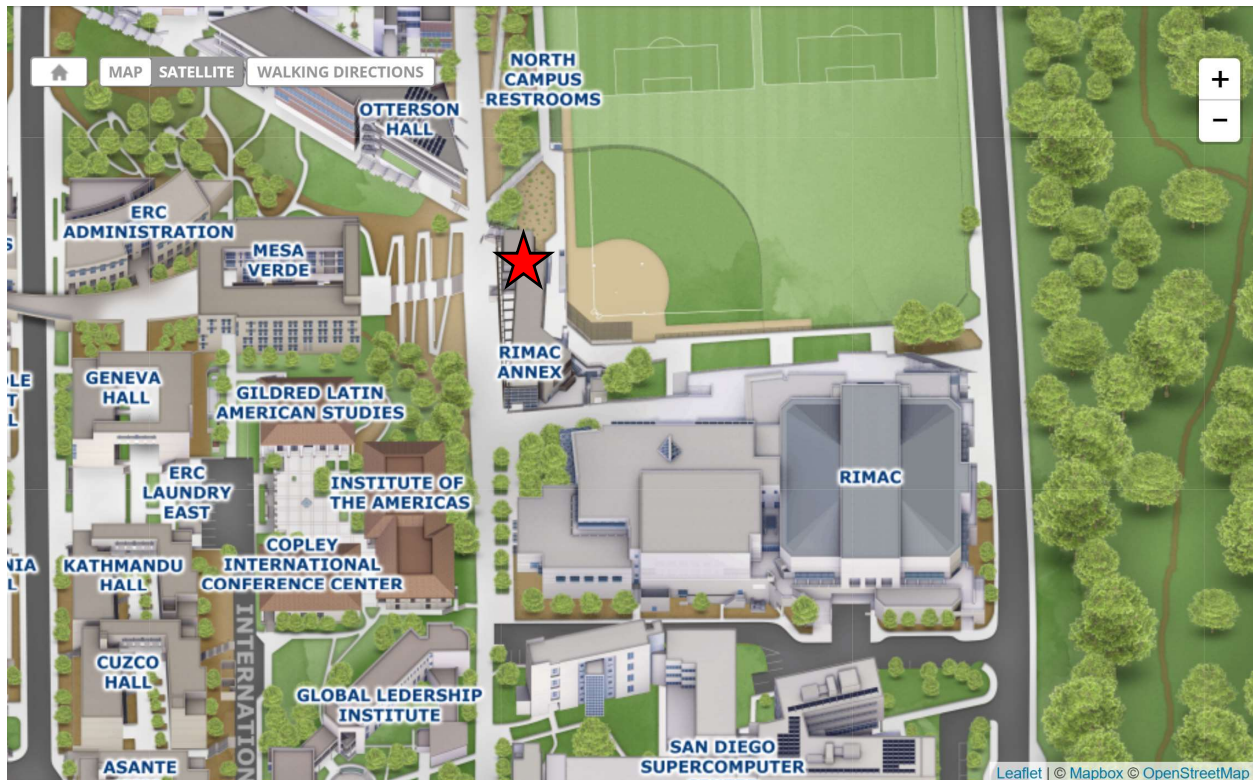

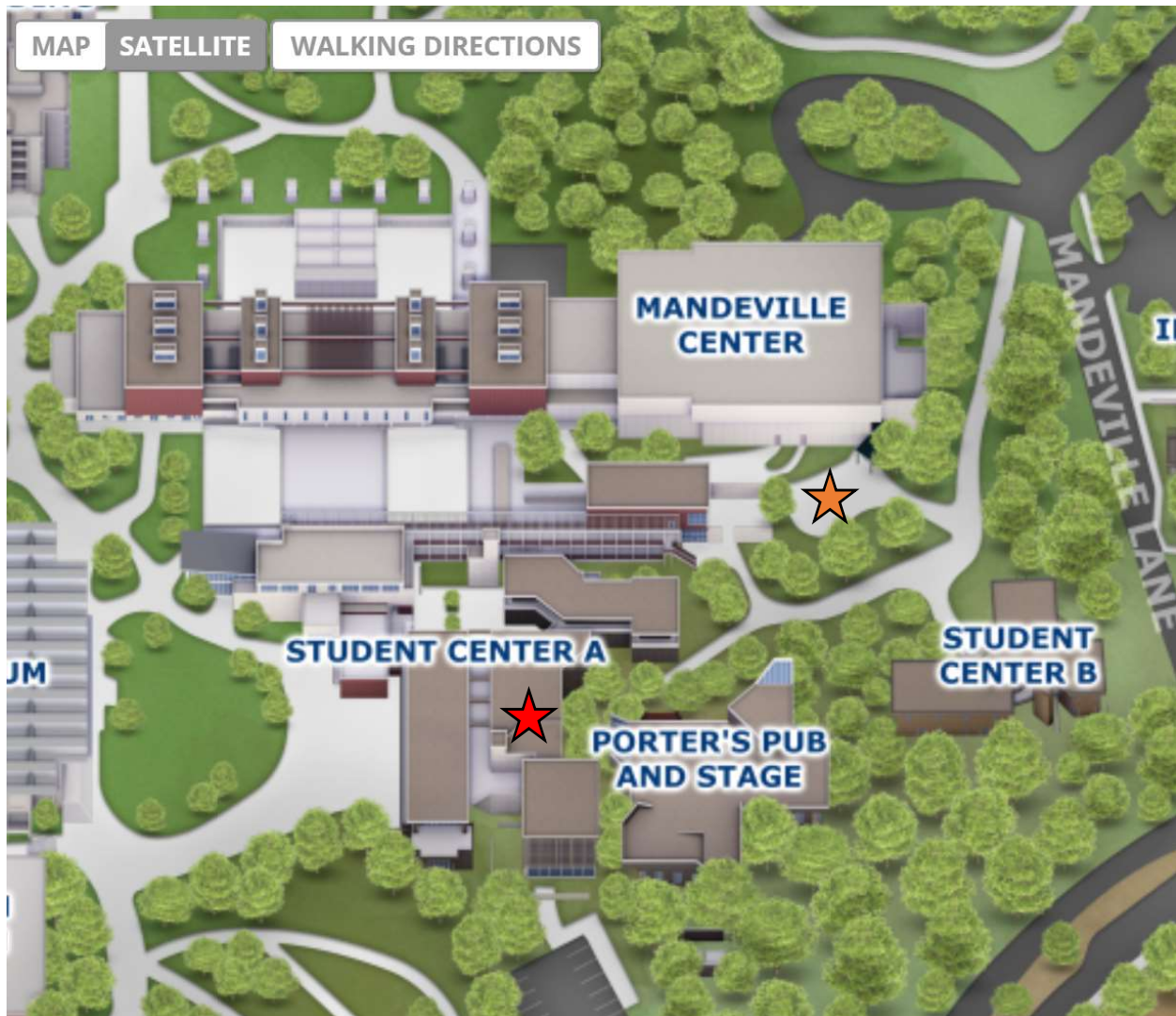
